Performace Measurement & Evaluation

Treatment Courts engage in ongoing data collection, **performance measurement**, and evaluation to assess adherence to the Ten Key Components, Wisconsin state and NADCP national standards, **evidence-based practices**, and specific program goals and objectives. Performance measurement is an on-going process that provides the treatment court team with timely information to monitor program performance in key areas. **Program Evaluation** is a periodic, often more formal process to review program processes, outputs, outcomes, and impacts, to assess how well the program is working (US Government Accountability Office, 2011).

Common Issues

Removing users

Program changes

Entering referrals into the wrong program

Duplicate referral entries

Do a CORE search

Declined participation

 Should not also select ineligible unless there really was also a reason/situation found ineligible. Sometimes eligibility will be "Not Determined"

Use the hover helps



Common Issues

"Other" usage

- Be sure to look at all options first
- Are keeping list of necessary additions

Drug Test Outcome

- If a participant tests positive for an authorized substance only, the Test Outcome should be Negative- No Unauthorized Substances Detected rather than Other.
- If didn't test (in custody, sick, in tx etc.) should select excused if considered excused, otherwise no show/positive if not excused and you're considering it positive rather than choosing Other.


